The answered questions should be sent back to us, possibly with meaningful pictures and together with this sheet. We will then put together the collected answers as an online blog.

Please write your memories and answers in English, add pictures, and try not to write more than 350 words.

1. What memories of the war, of the Holocaust, are there in your family? Was it talked about? If yes, how? (Have you met survivors of the Holocaust yourself?)
2. How do you remember the Second World War/Holocaust in your country? Are there e.g., memorial days? Memorials? Is it an issue in your society?
3. What is the significance of the topic of remembrance work for you?
